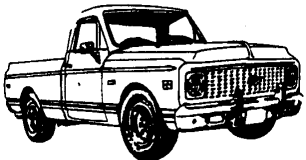

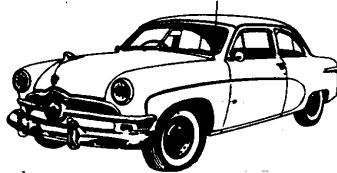
SPONSOR **TOMAHAWK DOWNTOWN BUSINESS COUNCIL**
